

COSTA RICA SEA TURTLE CONSERVATION

Typically, your workdays will alternate among various work sites. For instance, on Monday, you may be assigned to work with the turtles, while on Tuesday, you'll be engaged in activities related to the mangroves, and so on. This schedule aims to offer a broad overview of what you can anticipate throughout your week.

At some point during the week, you will have a designated free day, which you can use for additional booked excursions or for your personal exploration and relaxation. Three meals will be provided daily.

Sunday: Day 1:

- Morning: Pick up at Puerto Jimenez Airport or from the bus stop.
- Afternoon: Settle into accommodations and introduction.
- Evening: Free time

Monday: Day 2:

- Morning: Explore the area & start with project work around 7:30am.
- Mid-day: Lunch.
- Afternoon: Work ends around 3pm
- Evening: Free time.

Tuesday: Day 3:

- Morning: Explore the area & start with project work around 7:30am.
- Mid-day: Lunch.
- Afternoon: Work ends around 3pm
- Evening: Free time.

Wednesday: Day 4:

- Morning: Project work around 7:30am.
- Mid-day: Lunch.
- Afternoon: Work ends around 3pm
- Evening: Free time.

Thursday: Day 5:

- Morning: Project work around 7:30am.
- Mid-day: Lunch.
- Afternoon: Work ends around 3pm
- Evening: Free time.

Friday: Day 6:

- Morning: Project work around 7:30am.
- Mid-day: Lunch.
- Afternoon: Work ends around 3pm
- Evening: Free time.

Saturday: Day 7:

- Departure to airport or to bus stop. A taxi can be arranged to the airport (30 minutes away), or someone can accompany you to the bus stop. The bus departs at 5am on Saturday.
